- Send one adult for every 5 youth. If you have an odd number of youth and aren't sure what to do about advisors, call Peter Green (914 414-1226.)
- Please try to reimburse the advisor fees, and contact us if your attendees need help with the \$60.
- The registrar is looking for assistance in making sure attendees are registered early, and get their paperwork/payments in before the event. The registrar more than understands the wide range of compliance amongst UU parents when following directions, but he appreciates any help he can get. Did we mention that space is limited?
- **Stress to your drivers the importance of arriving on time so your youth don't miss out.** The beginning of Saturday morning is icebreaker/ tone-setting/get-acquainted stuff. **Much of the value of the weekend is lost if you're not there.**
