

Universalist Convocation 2007 Scheduled for May 5-6

“Universalist Peace Witness” is the theme of the Universalist Convocation 2007 (Convo 2007) at All Souls UU Church in Bellville, Ohio, May 5-6. The Rev. Ron Rembert, chair of the Department of Religion and Philosophy at Wilmington College (Ohio), gives the keynote address on Saturday morning. Wilmington College was established by the Society of Friends, long known for their peace witness.

The Universalist Convocation is an annual, national gathering of people who have roots in Universalism or who identify as Universalists.

The Convo Annual Business meeting is scheduled for Sunday, followed by morning worship led by John Martin.
