The show and all receptions and presentations will be at 28 - 30 E. 35th. St, NYC.

The artgroup@cc has a number of goals, long-range, that we hope to accomplish: fostering and exhibiting our talents, developing an artistic awareness and love of art in other members of the church, drawing toward us and the church outside visitors who may stay to support the church, and becoming an art center in the neighborhood.
