Tending the Compensation Booth at General Assemble, I noticed how proud many congregations were to receive their "Fair Compensation – Committed or Practicing" ribbons to attach to their badges. Is your congregation among those that might be eligible to celebrate your "Fair Compensation" status?

The Compensation Consultants across the country are undertaking an update of all the congregations in their districts. We will be re-certifying congregations that have already earned the designation and certifying congregations that are "Practicing" or "Committed" Fair Compensation congregations. "Committed" means that the congregation has made a commitment to fair compensation for all its staff and has a written plan to reach that standard in three to five years. Whatever the situation, many congregations appreciate knowing where they are in regard to fair compensation!
