She recently completed 2 terms as LREDA representative to the Council of Church Staff Finances of the UUA and is currently the chair of the LREDA Grant Committee.

Andrea Lerner:

Andrea Lerner is the RE Program Consultant for the Metro NY District, serving 51 congregations in NY, NJ, PA and CT. She has been involved in religious education for 12 years, serving as DRE in Orlando, FL, San Antonio, TX, and Austin, TX, which range in size from 250 members to 700 members, and as informal mentor to DRE's from small congregations. She also served on the Board of the Liberal Religious Educators Assn (LREDA) for five years as Membership Chair.
